### ◆ Eligibility and Nomination Criteria:

- The nominee has demonstrated a dedicated, ongoing commitment to the volunteer sector through sharing their expertise, skill set, and knowledge with nonprofit organizations in the North Georgia Community Foundation (NGCF) region (shown on [www.ngcf.org](http://www.ngcf.org)).
- He/she consistently demonstrates a passion for helping others.
- Nominee shows leadership through example and is a significant contributor to the organization/community.
- He/she advocates volunteer participation to peers.

### ◆ Narrative summary addressing the following criteria for recognition:

- Summarize the nominee's significant volunteer achievements/accomplishments through nonprofit organizations in NGCF's region. Please list specific organizations and projects.
- Briefly state why you think the nominee is deserving of the recognition.
- Describe how this individual's impact will make long-term benefits to the North Georgia region.
- Please specify if the nomination is for one person or a couple.
